*Funds for GA positions are allocated based on levels set by the Stamp Student Union, which in turn follow the <u>University's Minimum Graduate Steipend Levels</u>, per the GSG Bylaws Section 7.4.D: *Stipend levels for all assistantships will be set at the rate established by Stamp Student Union and Office of Campus Programs*. The allocations in this budget assume the holder of the office would appropriately be placed at the highest level of compensation, Step III (i.e., Doctoral Student Advanced to Candidacy). If the holder of any GA office is appropriately placed at a lower Step (i.e., Step I for Master's Students, Step II for Pre-Candidacy Doctoral Students), the GA would be compensated at the rate appropriate for that step and the difference in funds would contribute to the budget's buffer.
