¹ This bill is amendable through standard parliamentary procedures (i.e., Motion to Amend) with the condition that the total budget allocation remain constant; per the GSG Bylaws Section 7.3.B.2: *The Assembly shall have the right to amend the proposed budget by revising individual line items, though the total amount of the allocation must remain the same as originally proposed.*
