<sup>1</sup> This bill is amendable through standard parliamentary procedures (i.e., Motion to Amend) with the condition that the total budget allocation remain constant; per the GSG Bylaws Section 7.3.B.2: *The Assembly shall have the right to amend the proposed budget by revising individual line items, though the total amount of the allocation must remain the same as originally proposed.*

<sup>2</sup> Only representatives serving active 2022-2023 terms (i.e., not those newly elected in the Spring 2023 General Election, but including those re-elected) can vote for the Vice Presidents; per the GSG Constitution Section 3.5: *All voting representatives from the term ending will be eligible to elect both Vice Presidents.*
